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Insurance One Sheet for Schools

The North American Society of Homeopaths (NASH) is pleased to announce that School Members have access to competitively priced Professional Liability insurance for faculty and their students; the student policy is priced at a lower rate.

The applicant must be a Registered member of NASH. This coverage is only for the Professional Liability of that teacher (dean and/or owner of the school) and the designated number of students. Those students will not take any coverage with them when they leave the school.

To apply:

The Registered member needs to log into the NASH website and navigate to their 'member' homepage - click on the link for Professional Liability Insurance.

There are prompts to help you apply along the way:

- Select the Country where the school is located and click – “OK”.
- “Click here to register or log in” (On this page there is also a link for the list of Business Practices.)
- Scroll to the bottom to the “If this is your first visit click here” box and “Click Here to register.”
- Once registered, enter information in the top box labeled, “Existing insurance customers log in here”.
- “Click here to proceed to the insurance website.”
- Confirm that you want a Group policy.
- Confirm your state/province and click “Next”; or click on the link to change your state/province if you are in the US/Canada.
- Confirm your name, email address, add a school name & answer the three underwriting questions. Click “Next”.
- On the next screen you will need to...
 - Confirm your practice areas then click “Next”.
 - Choose Coverage Limits
 - Choose your Annual Gross Income
 - Answer whether or not you conduct business outside of the US/Canada
 - Add Computer Information coverage if needed.
 - Add Product Liability coverage if needed.

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Student Representative Responsibilities

Student Liaison Program: Rising Stars of the Homeopathic Profession

The Student Liaison Program is a benefit for each NASH School Member. Each School Member will endorse at least one Student Representative to act as a liaison with the NASH Board. There are forums that allow Student Representatives to learn about important issues that impact the profession and to share their own experiences as students and future practitioners of homeopathy. In turn, these Student Representatives will share NASH information directly with their fellow students. The Student Representative position is essentially a volunteer position for the school and NASH.

Mission:

The Student Liaison Program will create a bridge between NASH and students of homeopathy.

Goal:

To involve homeopathic schools as members of NASH, allowing their Student Representatives to dialogue with NASH and among themselves about issues affecting the homeopathic profession.

Guidelines:

- Homeopathic schools whose main purpose is to teach classical homeopathy can become members after paying an annual fee.
- One or more students are appointed by the School Member to participate in this program.
- Student Representatives are to be at a point in their studies to allow participation for more than 1 year.
- Student Representatives are not to have a conflict of interest in their role. It would not be appropriate for the Student Representative to be teaching or in an administrative role at their school.
- One NASH Board member will facilitate this program using appointed committee members, as needed.
- Each Student Representative will receive a free Student Membership during their term as liaison for their School.

Duties:

- Student Representatives shall attend all web meetings specifically for Student Representatives and NASH Student Members.
- Student Representatives shall attend a minimum of 6 total of the monthly webinars for NASH members or the NASH webinars open to the larger homeopathic community.
- All Student Representatives shall attend the Annual NASH Members Meeting.
- Student Representatives shall encourage their fellow students to join NASH as Student Members.
